Additionally, we can confirm that earlystage negotiations are actively underway with local Teamsters in Flint,MI. We strive for agreements that provide wins for our associates, the union, our company, and our customers. AWC always has and will continue to negotiate in good faith with the Teamsters.

Sadly for our associates, customers, and support staff at our Amapolis Junction location, our recent labor negotiations there were not successful. Our associates expect the same dignity and respect we strive to give them, and this means honoring their seat at the table and voice in the room – something national Teamsers did not allow, resulting in the worst case scenario of swift, painful, and plainly avoidable local job losses at the CSX fun location.

Our focus remains on achieving resolutions that protect local jobs, ensure stability for our business and our loyalcustomers, and preserve our ability to negotiate with local associates in Flint.

We thank you for your unwavering support, and we will share updates as current and upcoming talks progress.
